CONFIRMATION: The sacrament will be administrated to the young people of each school separately this year – Anahorish Tuesday 25 August 5pm. St Trea's Wednesday 26 August 5pm. It is expected that priests will be delegated as celebrants this year. Each confirmation family will have received an online link to help the young person to prepare spiritually for the sacrament and it is recommended that this be used. There was not time for preparation in the schools before lockdown. Any child who did not make their first communion in the parish should provide a certificate of baptism.

PUBLIC MASSES: Regulations include cleaning/ sanitising of the Church after each ceremony, observing proper distance – 2m if possible - having stewards for larger gatherings. Numbers will be limited. Next weekend again (18/19 July) we invite those parishioners in Ballymaguigan who live beyond St Trea's school to attend the vigil Mass, and those who live on Creagh Road and beyond, to border of Bellaghy (excluding Bannside) to attend the Sunday morning Mass - (on the 25/26 July it will be parishioners from Derrygarve, Aughrim Road, Airfield Road & Bannside for the vigil, & the remainder of Ballymaguigan for the 10am Sunday Mass).

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended.

Volunteers to steward and clean are to be provided by the area attending. We are grateful for those who have already volunteered. Young people and those not shielding are invited to help our parish in this time of need.

WEEKEND MASSES: (limited numbers as above) Saturday 7pm & Sunday 10am

WEEKDAY MASSES: 10am (except Monday 7pm) Volunteer dependent.

CONFESSIONS: Saturday 5pm

ROSARY: 7pm. Led by a parishioner at home each evening. All are invited to join at that time to pray for protection from Covid 19.

CHURCH HEATING: Since our fan propelled heating system has the potential to circulate any covid 19 virus present in the congregation, the parish committees have recommended that it be replaced with a conventional radiator system. Permission has been given in principle by the Building & Development committee of the Archdiocese to install a gas fired system. It will take some time to have the scheme ready to go – not before Confirmation and First Communion ceremonies.
