The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended.

Volunteers to steward and clean are to be provided by the area attending. We are grateful for those who have already helped especially new volunteers and young people.

In order to support the NHS TEST AND TRACE PROGRAMME, we are taking contact details (name and telephone number) for all worshippers, as well as recording times (apart from weekend Masses) entering and leaving St Treas Church. Please note this applies to all weekday Masses and private prayer.

WEEKEND MASSES: Sheets are available at the Church doors. You are invited to sign your name and phone number on way in or out.

Records will be held for 21days then destroyed and used only for test & trace.
