**WEEKEND MASSES:** (limited numbers) Saturday 7pm & Sunday 10am

**WEEKDAY MASSES:** 10am (except Monday 7pm, Saturday 11am)

**CONFESSIONS:** Saturday 5pm

**CHURCH OPENING TIMES:** For private prayer (during pandemic) Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 6-7pm. Closed Wednesday. Saturday & Sunday 5-7pm.

**ROSARY: 7pm.** All are invited to join at that time to pray for protection from Covid 19.

**WEEKLY COLLECTION: Holy Land collection** 12/13 September. This has been postponed from Good Friday due to the lockdown. It is the main source of income for the sustainability of the Christian identity in the Holy Land.

**PUBLIC MASSES:** Regulations include cleaning/ sanitising of the Church after each ceremony, observing proper distance – 2m if possible - having stewards.

**FACE COVERINGS** are a normal feature of life now. They should be worn at all ceremonies in the Church. (exceptions are those who are medically exempt).
