In November we remember all our dead. Palm crosses will be available to carry the names of our loved ones. They will be remembered at Masses through the month.

POPE JOHN PAUL II AWARDS. Volunteers are required to manage the upcoming award scheme. We hope to give out the Pope John Paul II Awards shortly.

The Diocese is organising a Synod in 2024. We will have a listening process in the diocese over the next two years in preparation for the Diocesan Assembly in 2024, but parallel to that there will be a consultation in the coming months for the Synod in Rome in 2023 and over the next few years for the National Assembly or Assemblies in 2026.

MASS next weekend 30/31 October we invite those parishioners in Ballymaguigan who live beyond St Trea's school to attend the vigil Mass, and those who live on Creagh Road and beyond to border of Bellaghy to attend the Sunday morning Mass.

PLEASE NOTE: While it is now a legal requirement to wear face coverings entering and leaving the church, we strongly recommend and encourage that they be worn during all ceremonies.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays remains suspended. Because of the pandemic, numbers will be restricted to the capacity of the church. We intend to live-stream the main ceremonies. It is important to work along with the stewards.

Volunteers to steward and clean should be provided by the area attending. We are grateful for those who have already volunteered but uptake has not been sufficient. Public Mass is not permitted in their absence. Young people and those not shielding are invited to help our parish in this time of need. **Appeal for more stewards** with number at the weekend Masses increasing we are seeking volunteers to help people to find a seat.
