Collections are being taken up throughout Ireland, with us weekend 27/28 November.

COVID RESTRICTIONS: As society continues to open, we intend to ease restrictions in the church. From the beginning of Advent, we hope to close only every second seat and discontinue the district arrangements.

UNIVERSAL SYNOD: This involves consultation with every member of the Church. Initially four questions have been given for consideration. Copies will be available in the porch and on the parish website as well as Facebook. Replies can be made online or sheets placed anonymously in the box provided. Results will be forwarded to the diocesan office.
