**WEEKDAY MASSES:** 10am (including Monday). Monday & Wednesday also have Mass at 7pm.

**CONFESSIONS:** Saturday 10.30am & 5pm

**CHURCH** open for Private Prayer daily 10.30am until dusk.

Tuesday 1 Nov Feast of All Saints is a Holy day of Obligation. Mass at 10am, Vigil Mass Monday at 7pm

Wednesday 2 Nov All Souls Day Mass at 10am & 7pm (on Wednesday).

Plenary Indulgence for the Holy Souls once per day from 1 to 8 Nov by visiting a graveyard and praying for the dead. Usual conditions apply (attending confessions within a week and receiving Holy Communion and praying for the Pope's intentions).

Thursday is the feast of St Malachy former Bishop of Armagh.

**VISITATION OF THE SICK:** Those who wish to receive Holy Communion are asked to contact Fr. Fox. Those who wish to bring Holy Communion to family members should call in to the sacristy to be commissioned.
