Mother Mary's Missionary Sisters of St Columban (SSC) were established in 1931, and established schools, hospitals, and training colleges throughout Uganda.

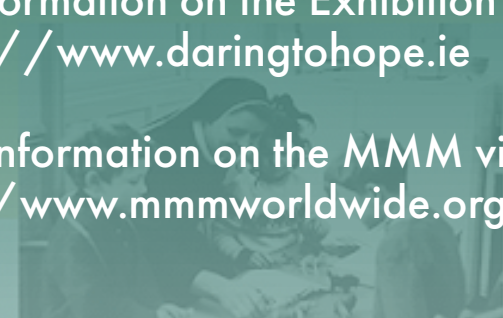


Undated - Hong Kong
