



## World Day for Consecrated Life, February 2, 2025

In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day for women and men in consecrated life. This global celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Feast is also known as Candlemas, the day on which candles are blessed symbolising Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples. The Jubilee of Consecrated Life will take place in Rome October 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> which will gather Religious from all over the world.

There are several ways to celebrate World Day for Consecrated Life.

- You are welcome to use the specially prepared Prayers of the Faithful – attached.
- If there are congregations in your parish/diocese, maybe welcome them to a local celebration. (Some dioceses will mark this on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, other celebrations can take place later in the year.)
- If there are members of your parish who are members of Religious Life, but live elsewhere, it is a good opportunity to remember them.
- If you have schools in your parish/community that were set up by a Religious Order and may be now part of one of the new Trusts, suggest to local chaplains and RE Teachers to invite students to research the word and origins of their school ethos.
