MASS FOR DECEASED RELATIVES: Saturday 16th November 10am.

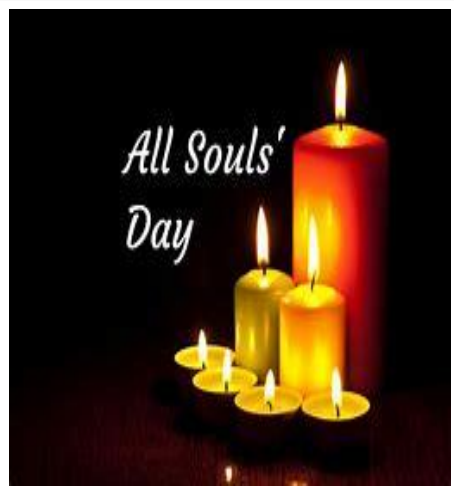
The dead will be remembered at Masses throughout November. Please write the name of your relatives on the palm crosses available in the porch and leave in box provided at the altar.

GRAVEYARD: Because burial ground in the parish is a very limited resource it is important to use it efficiently. For this reason, it is important that all new graves be deep enough for two coffins (a double grave is double deep). Only when more than two burials in a plot will be required can a double width be allocated. Guidelines can be read in the Church porch or on the parish website. (www.sttreas.info)
