CHURCH open for Private Prayer daily 10.30am until Dusk. WEEKEND MASS: SUNDAY 10.15am WEEKDAY MASS: 10am. ADORATION: Wednesday & Friday 10.30 - 11.30am. ASH WEDNESDAY MASS: 10.00am (No evening Mass). SICK & HOUSEBOUND: Mon, Tues & Fri this week in the usual order.

ASH WEDNESDAY: is a day of Fast (18th birthday until 59th birthday) & Abstinence (14th birthday onwards). Lent is a season of renewal through prayer and the word of God. It is characterised by a spirit of penance and almsgiving.

FORMS OF LENTEN PENANCE: The following are suggested:

Abstaining from meat or some other food, alcohol or smoking;

Making a special effort at involvement in family prayer;

Visiting the Blessed Sacrament; Making the Stations of the Cross;

Helping the poor, sick, old or lonely;

Fasting from all food for a longer period & giving what is saved to the needy.

Social Media outlets offer plenty of opportunity for restraint especially in Lent. This applies also to Fridays throughout the year.

GRAVEYARD: Because burial ground in the parish is a very limited resource it is important to use it efficiently. For this reason, it is important that all new graves be deep enough for two coffins (a single grave is double deep). Only when more than two burials in a plot will be required can a double width be allocated. Guidelines can be read in the Church porch or on the parish website. (<u>www.sttreas.info</u>)
