HOLY FACE NOVENA: The novena will begin on Wednesday 5th August @ 7pm and every first Wednesday of the month thereafter.

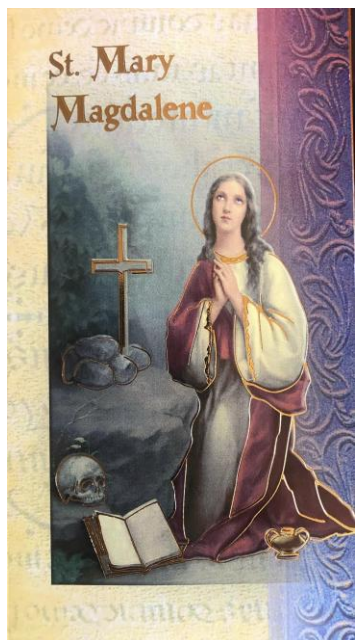

GRAVEYARD: Because burial ground in the parish is a very limited resource it is important to use it efficiently. For this reason, it is important that all new graves be deep enough for two coffins (a single grave is double deep). Only when more than two burials in a plot will be required can a double width be allocated. Guidelines can be read in the Church porch or on the parish website.
